

1) Penalty shootout Challenge

1.1 Registration

- Form a team of 4 participants. At least 2 participants in the team have to be 12 years old and below.
- Participants are required to bring their identification card for verification.
- Registration will be done on-site through a Registration Form
 - **Details required:** Team member's names, IC number (last 4 digits only), Age, Team leader's contact information (contact number and email)
- Participants are only allowed to join one team.

1.2 Objective

- Your team has to attain the highest points in the penalty shootout.
- Your team will be awarded points when you score goals through the target banner.
- Points ranging from 5-60 will be awarded based on where the football lands on the target banner.

1.3 Rules

- Your team will have 4 balls and 1 money ball (a total of 5 balls). A money ball shot will be a double point. For eg. If your money ball shot was 5 points, you earn 10 points.
- Each participant has to kick at least once.
- Kicking distance is 5m from target banner.
- When there is a tie of points between two teams in a day, a ballot will be conducted by the game master.
- For participants 12 years old and below, you will be given size 3 football to kick.
- For participants above 12 years old, you will be given size 5 football to kick.

1.4 Competition format

- Penalty shootouts are held at 8 sports centres on different dates.
- One team who has the highest score on each event day will emerge as the winning team.

1.5 Prizes

- ICC tickets will be given to each participant of the winning team.

2) Penalty Shootout (Public/individual)

2.1 Penalty shootout

- An individual can participate in the penalty shootout that is open to the public.
- You will be given 3 balls for each try.

2.2 Objectives

- Your main objective is to obtain at least 40 points.
- You will be awarded points when you score goals through the target banner.
- Points ranging from 5-60 will be awarded based on where the football lands on the target banner.
- You are required to collect a wristband if you meet this objective.

2.3 Prizes

- Singapore Football Festival Memorabilia Mini Football will be given to individuals who have met the objective.

2.4 Redemption of prizes

- You will be required to scan a QR code after completing the activities at each activity site.
- You will be able to redeem prizes once you completed all 4 activities: Mini Soccer Golf, Football Darts, AFA Penalty Shootout Challenge, Football Try-outs.
- You can proceed to the redemption counter to redeem prizes.

3) Terms and conditions

- Game masters have the right to disqualify teams/individuals who do not adhere to the rules of the game.
- Rules are subject to changes by the Game masters.
- Highest Scores for the team category will be broadcasted on social media after each event day.
